Enhanced Departmental Boards form the collective strategic and operational leadership of Departments, bringing together Ministerial and Civil Service leaders with NEBMs, who are appointed by the Secretary of State as experts from outside government.

Vacancy description:

NEBMs exercise their role through influence and advice, supporting as well as challenging the executive. They:

- Advise on performance and on the effective management of the Department.
- Provide support, guidance and challenge on the progress and implementation of the operational business plan.
- Are involved, as appropriate within the principles set out by the Civil Service Commissioners, in recruiting, appraising and ensuring suitable succession planning of senior executives.
- Form an audit and risk assurance committee.
- Form a nominations and governance committee.
- Meet other non-executives across government and the Government Lead NEBM (Lord Browne of Madingley) from time to time to share best practice and to ensure Departments learn from the successes and failures of comparable organisations.
- Report their views in their own section of the Department's annual report.

Feed their views back to the Prime Minister and the government lead NEBM, through the lead NEBMs' network.
