Non-Executive Director of NHS Resolution

The Secretary of State for Health and Social Care is looking to appoint two Non-Executive Directors to NHS Resolution. One role will bring commercial expertise, and the other will bring primary care expertise.

On 1 April 2017, NHS Resolution (formerly the NHS Litigation Authority) launched a new five year strategy which expands its historic remit of claims management and has a greater focus on prevention, learning and early intervention, to avoid unnecessary court action.

As a Non-Executive Director of NHS Resolution you will have the ability to analyse complex data and to draw balanced conclusions from the information presented to you. You will have excellent communication skills and the ability to work in a corporate manner on the board of a national public body.

In addition to this, candidates applying for the commercial role will have strong commercial skills, to provide effective advice in areas such as strategic business development, customer relations and managing change.

Applicants for the primary care role will have an in-depth understanding of primary care, to provide effective advice on the strategic and operational management of primary care services.

Remuneration will be £7,883 per annum for a time commitment of 2-3 days a month. The Secretary of State for Health and Social Care determines the length of appointment, which is likely to be for 3 years.
