



Chair - The Review Body on Doctors' and Dentists' Remuneration

Ministers are seeking to appoint an individual of high calibre who has the necessary experience to provide strategic leadership and direction to the Review Body on Doctors' and Dentists' Remuneration (DDRB) in fulfilling its function as a public body.

The DDRB is independent and is responsible for advising the government on rates of pay for doctors and dentists working in the NHS in its annual report, conducting research and reporting on pay and related matters and visiting trusts and health units to meet staff and managers to gather information and views on pay and related issues.

We are always keen to receive applications from candidates with private sector experience however, we are looking for candidates who have:

- Chairing experience demonstrated with a successful record of strategic leadership and achievement
- Proven senior level experience in business, finance or human resources and an appreciation of public sector reward
- Intellectual flexibility with an ability to analyse and interpret information
- Independence of thought and effective influencing and communication skills with an ability to gain respect and keep the confidence of others, including Ministers, senior Government officials, representatives of employer and employee interests
- High standards of corporate and personal conduct and the ability to work in a team.

The Chair is remunerated at £350 per day for preparation and attendance of meetings, for a time commitment of 15 days per year, plus preparation time for reading meeting papers. The Secretary of State for Health and Social Care determines the length of appointment, which may be for up to a maximum of 3 years.
